CELLAR PRACTICES: All fruit is hand picked, hand sorted, destemmed and crushed

with 10-15% whole cluster into small open top fermentors. Cold soaked for 4 days, inoculated with specially selected yeast isolated from the Rhone Valley and fermented dry. Pressed into

100% French Oak barrels and aged for 16 months.

TASTING NOTES: This wine is inspired by the blends of Chateaneuf Du Pape of

the Rhone Valley in France. A blend of 65% Grenache and 35% Syrah. Dense, rich and chewy, with mocha-laced wild berry and blackberry fruit that's intense and full-bodied, gaining

depth and a minerally complexity on the finish.
